**Executive Committee:** Conducts all regular business during the interim between the meetings of the TEXPAC Board of Directors; The EC approves the contribution amounts given to candidates based upon input from the Candidate Evaluation Committee and the TEXPAC Board of Directors

**Candidate Evaluation Committee:** Evaluates candidates and makes recommendations to the Executive Committee for contributions/expenditures to/for candidate campaigns.

**District Chair:** Recruits members; solicits local input; keeps their district informed of TEXPAC policies, procedures and activities; coordinates effective communications with legislators; represents the TEXPAC Board in the community; helps identify and support candidates who are best for medicine.
